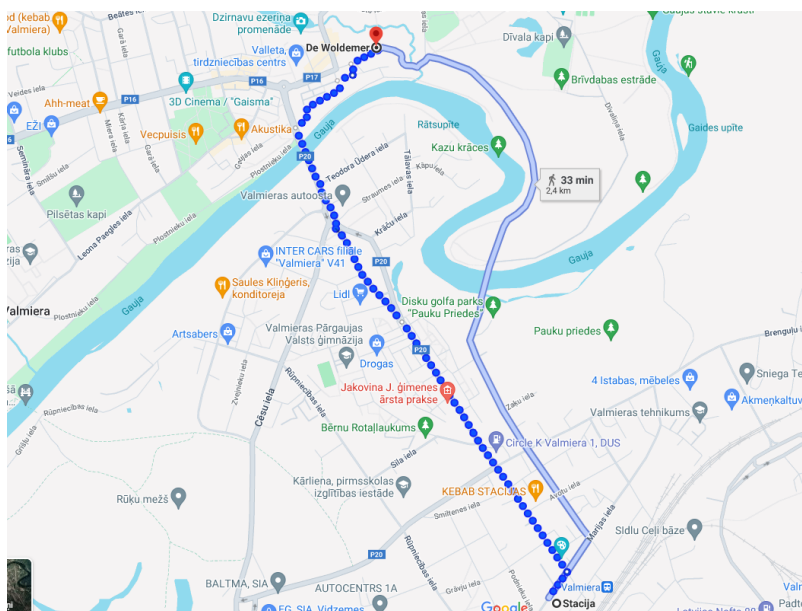


Valmiera museum and the new exhibition "De Woldemer"

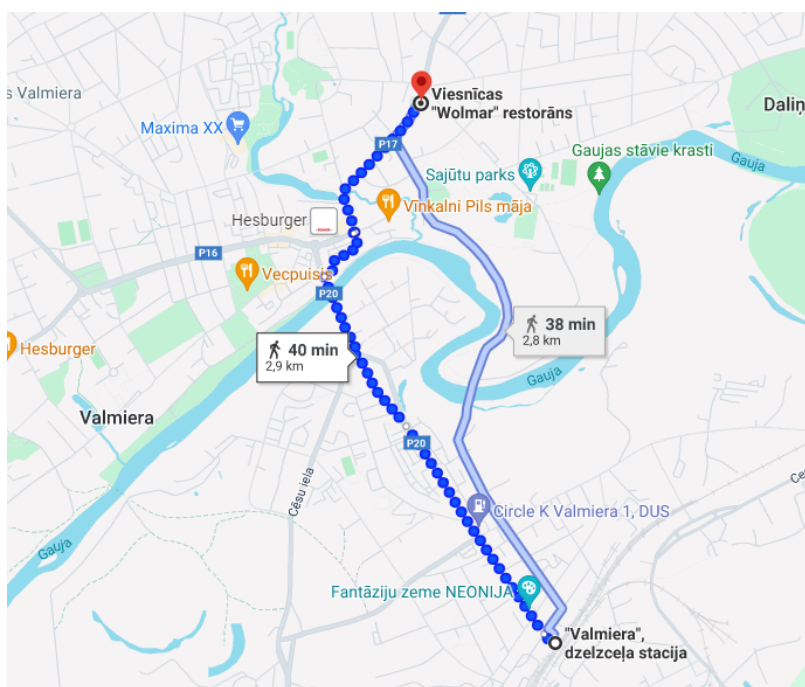




Hotel Wolmar
